**Guidelines for selected Candidates;**

- Timeline for admission process & Fees Payments

28 <sup>th</sup> February 2019 to 9 <sup>th</sup> March 2019	Verification of Original Documents and Fees payment of Rs. 40,000/-
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- Payment mode :
  - DD : in favour of "N.L. Dalmia Institute of Management Studies & Research" payable at Mumbai
- Documents to be submitted along with one set of zero copy at the time of admission
  - Secondary and Higher School Certificate and Mark sheet (Xth and XIIth standard).
  - First Year: I and II Semester Bachelor's Degree Mark sheet.
  - Second Year: III and IV Semester Bachelor's Degree Mark sheet
  - Third Year: V and VI Semester Bachelor's Degree Mark sheet (if passed and if the degree is of 3 years duration)  
Fourth Year: VII and VIII Semester Bachelor's Degree Mark sheet (if passed and if the degree is of 4 years duration).
  - Master's Degree First Year: I and II Semester Master's Degree Mark sheet
  - Master's Degree Second Year: III and IV Semester Master's Degree Mark sheet
  - Appearance Certificate from College: If a candidate has appeared for all the examinations of the final year of the Master's Degree and

the results are awaited, the candidate must produce a certificate from the College/University indicating that he/she has appeared for all the final year Master's Degree examinations, including practical, if any. (This is not the bona-fide certificate that you sent along with your first Application). Provisional selection will not be confirmed if the above is not produced at the time of verification.

- Copy of SET / PET / NET results.
- Work Experience Certificate/s (only for selected candidates)
- Letter of Permission from the employer/organisation.

Admission will be subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility requirements as confirmed through the verification of original certificates, mark sheets, etc. At any point in time during the process of admission or later, if it is found that the candidate does not fulfil any of the eligibility criteria, admission granted will be cancelled with immediate effect. Hence it is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that all the eligibility criteria are met before payment of fees. No representation for relaxation or reconsideration of the decision will be entertained in such cases.

Original documents will be immediately returned to the candidate after physical verification at the Admission department. However, migration certificate from other universities will be retained by the Institute as per relevant regulations in this regard

Migration Certificate issued by University/Institute authorities should be submitted by the Doctoral Students to the admission office on or before 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

● **Other Information**

- **Intake:** 6 candidates shall be selected out of 10 seats for the academics year 2019-2020 as per the UGC norms.
- Admission will be subject to the approval / eligibility from University of Mumbai.
- Selected candidate should go through the eligibility criteria before taking the admission.
- **Duration of Course :** The duration and structure of PhD program is usually of **Two years** of intensive course work.
- **Eligibility:** Eligibility norms as per the ordinance 0.5473 and 0.5476 of the University of Mumbai as mentioned in the VCD No Exam/Thesis/Univ/VCD/2414 of 2010. The candidate Post Graduated from other than the **University of Mumbai** must submit the **"Eligibility Certificate"** of University of Mumbai from Eligibility & Migration Dept. Kalina, Santacruz(E), Mumbai before taking admission to PhD degree course. The candidate is a post graduate of University of Mumbai or any other UGC recognized University with a minimum 55% marks (or a B grade, where grades are awarded), at his/her post-graduation degree and has successfully cleared the entrance test for Ph.D. (PET) conducted by the university prior to admission for the Ph.D. program in the given subject for the candidates having passed their postgraduate degree on or after 11th July 2009. For those passed before 11th July 2009, minimum marks can be 50%. 5% relaxation in the required percentage of marks will be given to the candidates of State of Maharashtra belonging to SC/ST/DT/NT/SBC/OBC categories.

- **O.6223 :- Eligibility** : A candidate may be eligible for admission to the Doctor of Philosophy program in a given faculty or subject, provided that any one of the following conditions are satisfied and that she/he fulfils the admission procedure as envisaged under the relevant ordinance :

1. The candidate is a post graduate and has cleared a prescribed examination such as GATE/GPAT/SET/NET/ (JRF) at any earlier time or is a fellowship or teacher fellowship holder of this university or any of the apex bodies such as CSIR/UGC/ICAR/ICMR/ICSSR/DBT/DST.

2. The candidate is a Post Graduate of recognized University working in a National Laboratory /Institute/ Government or reputed private organization with minimum five year teaching or research experience. However, such candidate shall be required to appear for an aptitude test approved by the University and to be conducted by the research Centre where she/he seeks admission for Ph.D. The experience is to be certified by the head of the institution/organization.

3. The candidate desiring to be conferred the Ph.D. degree in a subject other than the one in which he has obtained the Post Graduate degree of this university or any other UGC recognized university has cleared an aptitude test in the subject in which he so desires to be conferred upon the Ph.D. degree, either after or prior to successfully clearing the entrance test for Ph.D. (PET) either in the subject in which he has obtained the Post Graduate degree or the subject in which he desires to seek the Ph.D. degree.

4. The candidate being a foreign learner and possessing a degree equivalent to the post graduate degree of this University after successfully clearing the prescribed online test as approved by the University for the given faculty or subject and conducted by the respective research centre. The said research Centre shall be required to maintain the record of such online test administered for such candidate.

5. Applicants having age more than 60 years need permission from the Vice Chancellor to enrol for Ph.D.

The PhD candidate whose name is in the waiting list will receive a call from the Institute as and when a vacancy arises, in the event of Forfeiture / Cancellation of seats in the order of merit.
