

1st Year at NLDIMSR:

- 1. A candidate must have passed a three-years Bachelor's degree examination as per university rule from any UGC recognized University with preferably 50% at the time of graduation.
- 2. The candidate has to appear for any of the seven entrance examinations: CAT/XAT/CMAT/CET/MAT/ATMA/ NL Dalmia Aptitude Test.
- 3. The institute performs PI session as well as document verification of academic qualification from school to graduation.

Students who successfully complete the first year (11 months) of this programme at NLDIMSR will be eligible for the 2nd year at UW-Parkside, MBA Program.

2nd year at Wisconsin-Parkside, USA:

Students should clear a 16 credit foundation course at NLDIMSR with a minimum US equivalent GPA of 2.75 on a scale of 4.0. For an international student scholarship, a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a scale of 4.0 is required.

Many interventions in health and sanitation, education, environment, skill development and women and child welfare that have been planned by the students under the guidance of a senior faculty member, are being implemented by them as a part of their experiential learning. Medical camps, tree plantations, spreading awareness about using toilets and efforts to reduce open defecation are undertaken. This collaboration is expected to serve the twin purpose of touching and enriching the lives of the people in this village as well as providing valuable rural exposure to the MBA students of our institute through its social responsibility program.
