Scholarship Committee Report on Scholarships for PGDM Batch 2022-24 Students

An analysis has been done of 300 students (180 PGDM & 120 PGDM (Finance)) for considering the academically exceptional students for scholarship for their First Year at N. L. Dalmia for A. Y. 2022-23

Criteria for Scholarship for First Year students have been as follows:

- 1. Have been 'Admitted' to the PGDM/PGDM (Fin) program
- 2. Is in the Top 10 students in the Final Admission List of 300 students
- 3. Students having fulfilled criteria **1 & 2** and having the following CAT/XAT/CMAT/MH-CET percentiles will have the respective percentage of Scholarships offered for First Year PGDM/PGDM (Fin)
