The event commenced with the traditional lighting of the lamp by dignitaries followed by Saraswati Vandana. The assembled students and faculty members warmly welcomed the dignitaries and guests.



The event started with the introduction of Mr. Shailesh Dalmia, Hon. Secretary of N. L. Dalmia Educational Society, Mr. Mudit Dalmia, Vice-President of the N.L. Next, the keynote speaker for the day - *Mr. Gulshan Bhaktiani*, the founder and Director of Wellness Forever Medicare Private Limited was introduced and then he took over the lead for the event. He started the event with a unique way by playing a melodious song "*Woh Lamhein*, *Woh Baatein*" which grabbed the attention of audience and they started connecting with him. He gave an important lesson that "*Don't be afraid to fail*, *but be afraid to not to try*" which he

reflected with an insightful story. He instilled a spark within the audience to use knowledge for succeeding in career rather than just gaining a degree. He portrayed a powerful speech on the struggle and takeaways of his life learnings. The courage and conviction he displayed in making a difference in the lives of so many people is what makes him such an inspiration. The keynote address lasted for 40 minutes.



After the keynote address, a brief introduction of each panelist was delivered by the hosts. Once all the panelists were introduced and seated in the dais, the panel discussion commenced. The moderator *Mr. Raaj Chakravarti* led the discussion. He engaged the panelists by asking questions which revolved around the theme for the event "From Concept to Creation" where each panelists shared their views on the theme and how they started with their businesses and the hindrances which they faced and how they tackled it.

"Making positive changes in our lives is crucial for growth and development However, it's not enough to make a change - we must sustain it to make it a habit and a part of our daily routine!" are the golden words of *Mr. Vineet Patawari*. According to him, focusing on being a peaceful long-term investor is more important rather than being a full-time professional trader when it comes to managing his own money.

Mr. Ashutosh Mishra emphasized how kPaisa has solved problems of entrepreneurial India majorly focusing on Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities. He told that before starting any business first one need to gather inputs, the data and do a thorough study and research of the business and then step into the market. They are striving to empower individuals to take charge of their finances by giving easy access to financial services regardless of financial literacy.

Mr. Uday Wagh gave a lesson on how to analyse the risk and take the decision according to the circumstances of an individual, how much capital and efforts one must put to avoid the risk scenario, his main thought was to not start your business with your savings as this would not be a good calculated risk that one should take. According to him the core theme of concept to creation lies within asking question to yourself that how one will make his idea turn into reality.

Mr. Zubin Bhatt encouraged students to go after their own passion by sharing his own journey of how different aspects are needed to convince and deliver your idea, being in sales and marketing from past 10 years he has understood that it's a quite tough job and is one of the most difficult things in business buildup, but he had made his expertise in Building a strong relationship between him and market and hence Magic Lock was Born.

Ms. Radhika Bajoria emphasized that strength lies in accepting the reality and you can't live your life thinking that you will achieve something absolutely and at some point of time you will have to overcome failures and the only way to overcome failures is by supporting your team members and keeping a mindset that she is working for her team and gave a great learning that building a business is not one man's strength it is your team's strength.



Overall, the panelists gave insightful commentary on the realm of entrepreneurship and emphasized the essential qualities needed to succeed in any business venture. They underlined how crucial it is to comprehend the market, be flexible, persistent, and customer focused, having a clear goal and vision, as well as taking measured risks. The panelists covered a wide range of topics, such as the future of business, the difficulties faced by start-ups, and the influence of entrepreneurship on society. A lively Q&A session that saw many students participating and asking questions brought the panel discussion to a successful conclusion. The panelists offered insightful commentary.
