They also introduced the concept of the "3Ds" of leadership—avoiding Dhong (pretentiousness), practicing Dheeraj (patience), and demonstrating Dum (strength and conviction)—as guiding principles for effective leadership.





The event highlighted the importance of aligning strategic intent with actionable steps to achieve organizational goals. It also touched upon the value of traditional learning methods, such as handwriting, for improving understanding and memory retention in today's digital age. The discussions reinforced the need for leaders to cultivate self-awareness and address personal biases to make informed decisions in the context of Aldriven transformation.
